

Thunder Bay Conservatory of Music COVID-19 Health & Safety Policy 2021–2022

Occupancy

Rooms not to exceed 50% occupancy for any program or concert.

Mask Policy

All persons entering or remaining in our venues for the purposes of TBCM programming are required to wear a mask or face covering. The mask or face covering must cover the nose, mouth and chin. Temporary removal of the mask is permitted for wind and brass players actively playing their instruments. Wind and brass players without masks must maintain a 2 metre distance from all other persons in the room.

Vaccines

All eligible persons entering venues must present proof of vaccination against Covid-19.

Update

Children ages 5-12 are now eligible for the vaccine. Proof of first dose is required in this age group by March 14, 2022; and proof of second dose by June 16, 2022.

Screening

All persons entering our venues should complete a self-assessment: either Ontario's self-assessment or school screening. In the event the screening tells you to stay home or take other steps, do not attend programming that day.

Self-isolation

Venue

Most of of programs take place at Trinity United Church which is located at 30 Algoma St S.

Enter through the back gym doors located on Park Street opposite the Armoury.
